 - Possibility of hiring a bartender if it fits in the budget although this would be quite expensive and require tips
 - Have more ice on hand slows down the rate at which people drink alcohol
 - o Could be a good idea to book MSERT for the event
 - o For the summer gala, we do not necessarily need to collaborate with another group since GSAN is able to manage in terms of finances
 - We had very little support from the other group this time
 - Also, we can afford to make our ticket prices very cheap whereas other associations may not be able to do this
 - But it still may be nice to collaborate with another group for event attendees to meet new people
 - o For the photographer, have a shot list so that expectations are laid out
 - It would also be great if there was a specified photo booth so anyone who wants a photo knows where to get one, also better lighting
